

What is ResearchMatch?

ResearchMatch is a nonprofit recruitment registry that connects individuals with researchers for studies and surveys in their area or anywhere in the U.S.

Who can join ResearchMatch?

Anyone in the U.S., including Puerto Rico, can join ResearchMatch as a volunteer, regardless of age, ethnicity, or health. Those under 18 or needing help may register through a guardian. Some studies seek people with specific health conditions, while many also need healthy volunteers of all ages.
